

## **HSS Global Learning Course Development Stipends – Request for Proposals 2009-2010**

One of the goals of Kennesaw State University's (KSU) "Global Learning for Engaged Citizens" initiative is to expand the number of courses that contain at least 30% global content, which may include international and/or intercultural components. To achieve this goal, the Chair of the Global Learning Coordinating Council (GLCC) will provide each College with a limited number of \$1000 stipends to support faculty members<sup>1</sup> to develop such courses. Here are the criteria as developed by the GLCC:

- Give preference to proposals that either:
  - develop a new global learning course or
  - revise and rename an existing course that currently contains minimal or no global content into a course that qualifies as a global learning course (to view a list of approved courses, visit <http://www.kennesaw.edu/globalengagement/courses.shtml>).
  
- Give preference to proposals for courses that are likely to have an impact on the greatest number of students in one or (preferably) more of the following ways:
  - The course is a requirement for graduating in a major;
  - The course will be offered on a regular basis (e.g., at least once a year) starting in the academic year after submitting the proposal<sup>2</sup>; and
  - There are multiple sections of the course, and they all contain at least 30% global content.
  
- Give preference to proposals for courses that will facilitate one or more additional goals of the KSU's global learning initiative:
  - The course includes learning experiences and assignments that will support a student's application for global engagement certification (to view the application form, visit <http://www.kennesaw.edu/globalengagement/apply.shtml>); and
  - The course contributes to the program's Assurance of Learning initiatives by assessing one or more of KSU's Global Learning Outcomes for Graduating Seniors (to view a definition of each outcome, visit [www.kennesaw.edu/getglobal/learningoutcomes.shtml](http://www.kennesaw.edu/getglobal/learningoutcomes.shtml)).

### **TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL:**

Provide a description of the course development addressing how the proposal meets the above preferences.

Include a course syllabus

<sup>1</sup> Some faculty members (e.g., those in 12-month administrative appointments) may not be eligible for stipends. Upon approval of the Chair of the Global Learning Coordinating Council, faculty members may allocate some or all of the stipend to graduate assistants who contribute to course development.

<sup>2</sup> Special Topics courses that have not yet been approved through the curriculum committee process may receive the stipend; give preference to those Special Topics courses that are likely to be approved and will be offered on a regular basis.
